There are subsidies available if the cost of a program is stopping you from signing up:

**City of St. Albert Community and Protective Services**—for qualifying low income individuals and families wanting to register in a City of St. Albert program

**KidSport**—for sport program registration

**Rotary Club Reaching Out**—for school-age children to develop talents and lifelong interests

**Stay-at-Home Parents Support**—eligible families who have one parent at home or works, volunteers, attends school less than 20 hours per week

**The Brick Sport Central**—sports equipment for children and youth

Are you constantly nagging them to get out of the house? Fortunately St. Albert offers many child friendly programs and activities throughout the year at no cost.

- ⇒ Free admission to all **Arts and Heritage sites** with a variety of events, exhibitions, and programs throughout the year
- ⇒ **Canada Day**: events, activities, entertainment, fireworks, and more
- ⇒ **Cruisin' Clubhouse**: drop in games for school-age children at local parks in July and August
- ⇒ **Family Day Festival**: events, activities, entertainment, and more
- ⇒ **Kinex Arena Public Skating**: from September to March sponsored by Tim Horton's
- ⇒ **Kinsmen Rainmaker Rodeo**: parade and pancake breakfast (end of May)
- ⇒ **Northern Alberta International Children's Festival**: roving performers, face painters, balloon artists, outdoor stage entertainment (end of May)
- ⇒ **Snowflake Festival**: wagon rides, entertainers, tree lighting (end of November)
- ⇒ **Public Library**: admission to weekly programs with free library card
- ⇒ **Parks and Trails**: Lions Park, outdoor skating rinks, Red Willow Park trails, Woodlands Skateboard Park and Water Play Park
