Don't miss the bus!



Parents, the deadline for registering your child for yellow bus services for the 2020-21 school year is **June 30th**. Transportation routes are designed around applications received by this deadline.

Please note that we will follow Alberta Health Services and Alberta Education requirements for busing in the fall. Although we are uncertain what these requirements will be, we need to plan our routes over the summer so we encourage parents to register as soon as possible. Payment is not required until busing is confirmed.
